Ohio Medicaid's Next Generation managed care plans are being implemented on December 1, 2022. Ohio Medicaid members are encouraged to select the Next Generation plan that is right for them.\*

### Important Dates

#### Next Generation Plan Selection Period

**Now – November 30:** All eligible members can select from the Next Generation plans available

#### Next Generation Plan Effective Date

**December 1, 2022:** All eligible members begin receiving services through a Next Generation plan

Note: While members can select their Next Generation plan through the end of open enrollment on November 30, Ohio Medicaid managed care members will remain with their current managed care plan or in Medicaid fee-for-service until Ohio Medicaid's Next Generation managed care plans begin providing healthcare coverage in December of 2022.

\*The Next Generation managed care plan changes do not apply to MyCare Ohio plans, which will continue to provide benefits to Ohioans who receive both Medicaid and Medicare benefits, with enhanced coordination of medical, behavioral, and long-term care services. Additionally, OhioRISE enrollees will receive their behavioral health benefits through Aetna (the OhioRISE plan) and their physical health services through a separate managed care organization or fee-for-service Medicaid.
